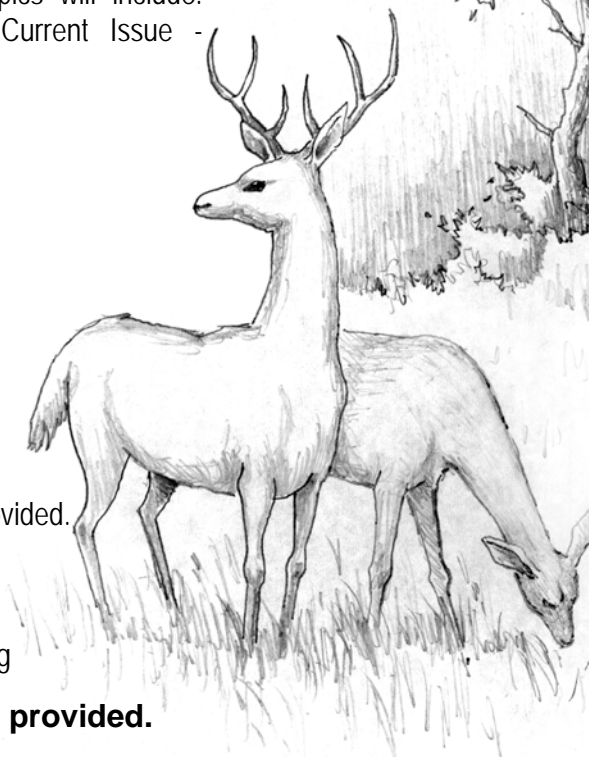




2009 New Jersey Envirothon Workshop
