

**New Jersey Envirothon
Rules for Team Presentations
May 8, 2010
Camp Sacajawea
Newfield, NJ**

- 1. The team presentation problem will be posted on the NJ Envirothon Website on Monday May 3, 2010.**
- 2. Teachers/Advisors are not permitted to provide answers or solutions for the presentations. Envirothon teams must prepare their presentations without assistance from their advisors.**
- 3. At the event there will be 3 Team Presentation Stations (Station A , B & C) in a sheltered area**
- 4. Your Team's Schedule during the Envirothon will include the Team Presentation Station**
- 5. You team will be permitted 5 minutes of prep time before their presentation**
- 6. An equal amount of judges will be present at each station/presentation area during each presentation.**
- 7. There will be a proctor on site to tally scores and keep time.**
- 8. Two teams will arrive at the each of the presentation sites every ½ hour (six teams total)**
- 9. The team with the lower number at each station will go first.**
- 10. The second teams will go into a designated area and wait 15 minutes.**
- 11. Presentation time is ten minutes with questions during the presentation.**
- 12. Teams will only be permitted to use the materials provided on site (flip chart and markers)**
- 13. Students may bring up to 5 (3" x 5") note cards for the presentation – NO OTHER FORMAT WILL BE PERMITTED. The note cards must be clipped together in order.**
- 14. Students must hand these note cards to the person registering their team on the morning of the Envirothon event. They will get these cards back during their 5-minute preparation and can use them during the presentation.**
- 15. Questions (up to one by each judge) will be asked within the 10-minute presentation.**
- 16. After the presentation judges will have 5 minutes to compile scores and give to proctor.**
- 17. The proctor will average the scores of the judges and send final scoresheet to scorekeeper.**
