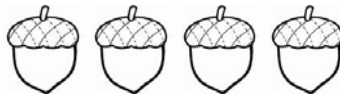

Sugar Maple

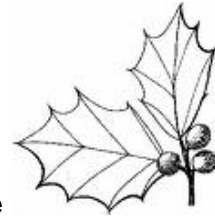
2. Evergreen (coniferous) trees that keep their leaves year round



Pitch Pine



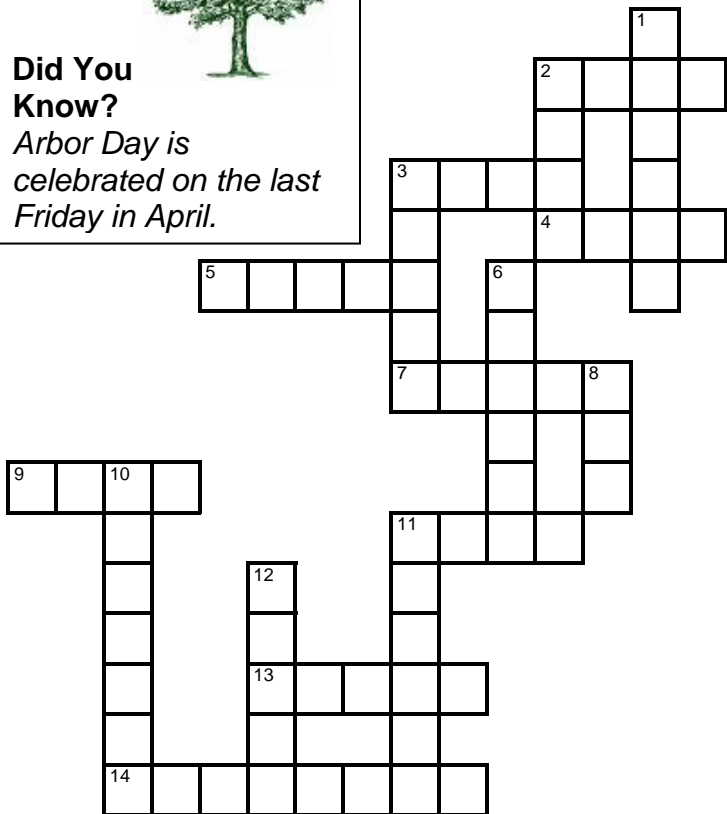
Eastern White Pine
